Greetings, Camp PossAbility Camper!!

We are eagerly anticipating your arrival at Camp PossAbility. Online you will find everything you need for Camp PossAbility—from the guidelines to the packing list to the medical forms.

In this packet you will find the following things:

- 1) Camp PossAbility packet—contains TWO forms that need signed by a physician (1 from Bradford Woods, 1 from Camp PossAbility)
- 2) Packing list—Everything you need to know about what to pack
- 3) Guidelines—Everything you need to know about staying safe and helping us create a great environment at camp
- 4) Med sheet—Everything you need to tell us about your meds, allergies, and procedures; **your doctor MUST sign the bottom of each sheet for this as well this year**

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- 1) Your doctor will need to sign both the Camp PossAbility application. Please make sure both forms are signed AND dated! If they are not signed, we cannot admit you to camp.
- 2) These forms are NOT to be signed before July 1, 2018.
- 3) We will need you to fill out a liability form when you get to camp. If you are traveling and need someone to sign for you, please let us know ahead of time and we will get you that form early.

NEW THIS YEAR:

- 1) The camper fee this year is \$450 and must be paid at registration to ensure your spot. If you are accepted for Camp PossAbility, this fee is NON-REFUNDABLE! This year, all campers will be required to pay the \$450 fee as Camp PossAbility works to raise the additional 75% of your fees with grants and scholarship funds.
- 2) NO immediate family members can volunteer at Camp PossAbility (parents/siblings) to help give the campers more independence.
- 3) Doctors must sign your medication forms this year (signature on bottom of each page to verify)

AS A REMINDER:

- 1) If you catheterize and do NOT take a prophylactic antibiotic, you must bring an antibiotic with you to camp (preferably filled but at least the script) in case of a UTI.
- 2) To help prevent fungal infections/yeast growth, ALL campers and volunteers are required to bring a bottle of Tinactin powder spray and a bottle of Tinactin powder (or Nystatin). You will need to show this at check-in.

Camp PossAbility is located at Bradford Woods, 5040 State Road 67 N, Martinsville, Indiana 46151. MapQuest should get you right there.

If you are flying in, you are responsible for your own transportation to camp. Camp PossAbility cannot do airport pickups at this time. Public transportation and taxis are available if needed.

If you need someone to sign your releases and liability forms at camp, please make sure the person bringing you to camp is a legal guardian.

Entrance to camp begins at 2 p.m. on Sunday, July 29, 2018. Campers should arrive no earlier than 2 p.m. and should arrive BEFORE 3 p.m. to be checked in. If you arrive early, you will have to wait in your vehicle until we are ready for you!

Please be prepared to wait in line and be patient that day as we get everyone to their appropriate places. The more closely you follow these instructions, the more quickly we can get everyone processed and ready for the week of fun!! Please tell your caregiver or guardian to allow at least an hour for processing.

Dismissal for camp will begin at 10 a.m. on Friday, August 3, 2018. Please tell your caregivers to arrive promptly if they are picking you up so that loading can begin at that time. All campers must have left by 11 a.m.
