



## Camp PossAbility

These guidelines apply for EVERYONE at Camp PossAbility and must be followed to ensure safety for all. Acknowledgement of these guidelines must be signed before camp starts.

### PERSONAL BOUNDARIES

- Stay within an arm's length of your volunteer or camper at all times. Once you arrive at camp, you should not leave the facility until camp is dismissed.
- Respect each person—their space, their personal items, and their bodies. Do not touch anyone or their belongings or take anything without permission.
- Never get into bed with another camper, staff or volunteer.

### BEHAVIOR

- No type of abusive behavior or comments—verbal, physical, or sexual—will be permitted at camp. If you act this way, you will be asked to leave and may be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. **YOU WILL ALSO NOT BE REACCEPTED FOR FUTURE CAMP WEEKS.**
- No cussing, swearing, or name calling at camp. If you cuss out anyone at camp, you will be told to leave and not readmitted in the future.
- Everyone at camp must have adult behavior (no temper tantrums or acting out). If you act out or throw a fit, you will be asked to leave and will not be readmitted in the future. If your caregiver is called, we reserve the right to discuss the issue with them.
- No refunds will be given if you are asked to leave and you will not be readmitted in the future.
- ABSOLUTELY NO** cigarettes, tobacco or other nicotine products (other than patches), marijuana, or alcohol are to be brought to camp. If found they will be confiscated and NOT returned, and the person bringing them may be asked to leave.
- NO chewing gum is allowed.

## **DIVERSITY**

- Camp PossAbility welcomes campers, volunteers, and staff from many backgrounds. People of different religions, beliefs, and sexual orientations should all find a safe place at camp. Conversations that bring up controversy should be handled with respect (and ended or avoided if necessary to maintain a friendship). If you instigate an argument or harass another individual, you will be asked to leave Camp PossAbility.
- Any games brought to camp must be pre-approved by CORE team and must be family friendly (appropriate for EVERYONE of all backgrounds).
- Keep conversations appropriate and inclusive of all audiences (including children). If you want to talk about personal/medical issues with other campers or the medical team, have those conversations in your cabins/"safe zones." NO conversation should involve derogatory or inappropriate comments about others or you will be asked to leave.

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- Do not use an activity area unless it is your designated time to be there—that includes the pool. You cannot swim without lifeguards on duty.
- Snacks must be stored in airtight containers; anything left open will be immediately thrown away. NO PEANUTS or peanut products are allowed whatsoever.
- Campfires are NOT to be started by anyone other than Eric unless designated by CORE team
- Cell phones should be on "airplane mode" for the week unless there is an emergency; no cell phones are to be used in cabins and are not permitted past the main area/gathering room.
- Closed-toed shoes (tennis shoes) must be worn at all times other than at the pool when pool shoes should be worn.
- Bedtime is 11 p.m. SHARP. Please make sure you get to bed on time and ask for help if you have any issues.
- No visitors at camp unless they are pre-approved/have submitted their background checks.
